- Ballots with the declared candidates' names will be distributed to active paid membership on May 13, 2019.
- The voting will take place from May 13 May 31, 2019.

5. <u>June</u>

- Twin Cities Chapter General Membership meeting will take place on June 20, 2019.
- The newly elected board members will be introduced and take their oath of office.
